From the Executive Director

As we approach the end of 2022, we look forward to the possibility of a new facility. After a few years of work, with the help of the Paducah Area Development District (PADD) office, and with the Calloway County Fiscal Court, we have submitted an application for a Community Development Block Grant. This grant will total almost ¾ of the funds that we need to start our new facility! We are expecting to know by early summer, and will keep you posted on the results. Other highlights in the next few months are:

1) WATCHing Art Work program, with a grant from the West KY Community Foundation and the Higginsons, partnering with Murray's W.A.T.C.H., Inc program for developmental & intellectually disabled adults continues to thrive. This program provides workshops twice a month with WATCH participants, creating hand stamped dishtowels & cards that are now sold in

our Art Market and Red Bug Yarn & Gifts.

2) We continue to offer work from over 40 local artists in our Art Market, as well as employing local artists and art educators for our youth and adult programming.

3) We are humbled and honored to receive the 2022 Governor's Award in the Arts for Community Arts! We thank Constance Alexander for nominating us & for the community for making it possible!

The MAG is fortunate to have an active board and wonderful volunteers, continued partnerships with Murray Convention & Visitors Bureau, Playhouse in the Park, Needline, MSU, W.A.T.C.H., Inc. and continued grants from Arts for All Kentucky and the Kentucky Arts Council

We look forward to going into 2023, focusing on our facility needs and expanding &/or adapting programming as needed to keep supporting artists and developing arts in our community!
